

## **Instruction Manual**



### **Technical Specifications:**

### **Connect the smart plug to Echo Devices.**

You can connect your Alexa Smart Home devices to Echo devices via Bluetooth connection with voice commands or Amazon Alexa app.

1. Connect smart plug to Echo with voice commands.
  - 1.1 Make sure your Echo is correctly configured and has access to the Internet.
  - 1.2 Make sure the smart plug is located within the Bluetooth range of Echo.
  - 1.3 Power on the smart plug, press and hold the power button for 5 seconds. The indicator light will flash.
  - 1.4 Use voice command “Alexa, discover devices” to activate Echo and order it to discover the smart plug.
  - 1.5 Echo will make a confirmation sound once the smart plug is connected to it.
2. Connect smart plug to Echo with Amazon Alexa App.
  - 2.1 Download and install “Amazon Alexa” app from App Store or Google Play.
  - 2.2 Launch the app and tap “Devices” or “More” on the bottom.
  - 2.3 Tap in order “+”, “Add Device”, “Plug”, “Other” and “Discover Devices”.
  - 2.4 When connection is established, you can view the ON/OFF statues of the smart plug and control it from your smartphone. You can also tap the Gear icon to rename the device

### **Bluetooth Mesh Networking**

You can create a Mesh network with multiple smart devices.

1. Connect all the devices to Echo.
2. Place the devices in desired locations where all of them are inter-connected with Bluetooth connection.

### **Operating the smart plug**

The smart plug can be controlled via voice commands or Amazon Alexa app.

1. Voice commands:
  - Alexa, turn on <device name>
  - Alexa, turn off <device name>
2. App control
  - Locate the smart plug in the device list and turn it on or off by clicking on the Power button.

### **Supported Echo devices:**

Echo 2nd Gen, Echo 3rd Gen, Echo Dot 2nd Gen, Echo Dot 3rd Gen, Echo Dot 3rd Gen with clock, Echo Plus 1st Gen, Echo Plus 2nd Gen, Echo Show 1st Gen, Echo Show 5, Echo Show 8, Echo Show 10, Echo Spot, Echo Input, Echo Flex, Echo Studio

### **Note:**

1. Please update your Echo’s firmware to the latest version before connecting your smart plug to it in order to have the mesh networking capability.
2. You can update firmware with voice command “Alexa, is my software up to date?”
