While the game is designed for people above nine after its assembly is completed. Plays between nine and 14 should operate under adult supervision. Please do not give it to children at or below eight. This assembled product (along with its package) shall stay away from infants and children.
















Operating Instructions for Front Arm Clutch


Operating Instructions for Front Arm Clutch


The clutch operates automatically. When a different actuating kit is installed, some mechanism in the front arm will be left unused or it's required to control other mechanism. The clutch makes it possible for the front arm to switch over functions at different modes and to avoid any damage from inadvertent operation. Besides, the clutch can also operate manually to correct engaging position of gears (for details, please refer to "troubleshooting").



Assembly of Clamp







Clamp

Maximum angles/length cannot be achieved in operation in all directions, and operation responses slowly in all directions.

- 1. Check the hydraulic system for excessive air. If there is excessive air, please go back to "hydraulic system venting" for operation.
- 2. Check if the handle is stuck at some position. If the handle is stuck, please go back to "handle assembly" to check if the assembly is correctly completed.

There is excessive resistance to operate the handle or the handle is impossible to be pushed (pressed)/operation responses slowly in all directions.

- 1. Check if the related hydraulic tube is badly bent. If yes, please go back to the related installation step to check if the hydraulic tube is correctly assembled.
- 2. Check if the related hydraulic cylinder piston is stuck. If yes, stably force to relieve the issue with hand (don't operate with excessive strength).

The clamp fails to rotate to maximum angle

- 1. Check the hydraulic system for excessive air. If there is excessive air, please go back to "hydraulic system venting" for operation.
- 2. Check if the part is stuck at some position. If yes, please go back to "front arm assembly" to check if the assembly is correctly completed.
 - 3. Apply wax on moving parts.

The clamp fails to rotate from the correct starting position

- 1.Please go back to "front arm assembly" to check if the gear is correctly engaged. If the arrow is not pointing to the right ahead, or B05 position is incorrect, please manually operate the clutch to OFF. Return the gear to seat and disengage the clutch to MESH.
 - 2. Check gear rack position. If the position is incorrect, please go back to "front arm assembly" to realign the gear rack.

Front arm clutch fails to operate

- 1. Check if rubber bands on both sides are broken. If yes, please replace.
- 2. Check if the clutch is stuck at some position. If yes, please go back to "front arm assembly" to check if the assembly is correctly completed.
 - 3. Apply wax on moving parts.

Magnetic lifting silo fails to disengage/engage

- 1. Check the rope length. If the rope length is not OK, please go back to "magnetic lifting silo assembly" to adjust the rope length.
- 2. Check if the parts are stuck. If yes, please go back to "magnetic lifting silo assembly" to check if the assembly is correctly completed.

Excavator bucket/magnetic lifting silo fails to secure on the front arm

- 1. Check if the rubber band of latch under the front arm has come apart. If yes, please re-mount the rubber band.
- $2. Please\ go\ back\ to\ "front\ arm\ assembly"\ to\ check\ if\ B21/B22/B23\ are\ correctly\ assembled\ and\ engaged.$

Water leakage

- 1.Locate the leakage. Re-connect the hydraulic tubes or bypass valves, and then go back to "hydraulic system venting" to operate.
- 2. The wooden parts that have become wet should be wiped with clean tissue immediately and then placed in a well-ventilated place. Do not put them under direct sun exposure. Perform "hydraulic system venting" when the parts have become totally dried up.

Hydraulic tubes become loose

 $1. If the \ hydraulic \ tubes \ become \ loose \ repeatedly, \ cut \ the \ end \ that \ has \ come \ apart \ by \ 1cm \ and \ then \ have \ it \ hooked \ up \ again.$

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
