



# PLEASE NOTE THAT THE FOLLOWING PICTURES ARE BASED ON THE DRIVER SIDE INSTALLATION

### STEP 1


Starting on the Driver/Left front of the vehicle, remove the plastic plugs, (or hex bolts), covering the threaded holes in the body panel, (Fig 1).

### STEP 2


Select the (1) Front Mounting Bracket. Attach the Bracket to the vehicle with (2) 8mm Hex Bolts, (2) 8mm Lock Washers and (2) 8mm Flat Washers, (Fig 2). Do not tighten hardware at this time.



(Fig 2) Attach (1) Front Mounting Bracket to the front mounting location


### STEP 3

Move along the body panel to the center (2nd) mounting location, (Fig 3). Select (1) Center Mounting Bracket. Repeat Step 2 to install the Mounting Bracket on center mounting location, (Fig 4). Do not tighten hardware.



(Fig 3) Driver/Left center (2nd) mounting location






# STEP 4

center mounting locations




(Fig 5) Driver/Left rear mounting location

Move along the body panel to the rear mounting location, **(Fig 5)**. Repeat **Step 3** to install (1) Rear Mounting Bracket to the 3rd and 4th mounting locations. Do not tighten hardware.


### STEP 5

Select (1) Running Board. Insert (8) 6mm T-Bolts into the channels in the bottom of the Running Board, (Fig 6), (4 T-Bolts per channel). Attach the Running Board to the (4) Mounting Brackets with (8) 6mm Flat Washers, (8) 6mm Lock Washers and (8) 6mm Hex Nuts, (Fig 7). Do not tighten hardware.

# STEP 6

Level and adjust the Running Board and fully tighten all hardware.

## STEP 7

Repeat **Steps 1—6** to attach the other side Running Board.

# STEP 8

Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.

#### **Attention**

To protect your investment, do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish.

Mild soap may be used also to clean the Running Boards.
