

4. Home Press to enter main menu.



Main menu

The first time power on, unit will be default into languages setting interface, select the needed country and language, press " $\sqrt{}$ " enter to main menu, functions are as below:





Radio: Shows the Radio interface.



Phone: Shows the Bluetooth connection interface.



Setting: Shows the Settings interface.



USB: Shows the USB playback interface for compatible files.



BT Music: Shows the music playback interface.



AUX: Shows the AUX interface.

Android Auto/CarPlay:

Shows the relevant interface based on your connected device.

Screen off:

Turns off the screen, to reactivate the screen simply press any part of the screen.

Radio Settings

Touch "Radio" in main menu to enter radio interface.





1. MAIN MENU: To return to the main menu



2. BAND: Switch between FM1/FM2/FM3/AM1/AM2



3. EQ: Enter the EQ settings interface



4. SCAN: Scans for available stations, long press to automatically search and save stations with the strongest signals into the presets.



5. LOC: Turns the LOC function on/off



6. GOTO: Shows the Radio tuning input interface, input the frequency directly or selected preset stations to start playing.



7. Scans for stations in reverse. Long press to search for stations automatically.



8. Scans for stations. Long press to search for stations automatically.

RDS Function

RDS will allow you to display information such as traffic status, radio station name and more. The unit can automatically switch to the strongest station based on the similar program.

AF: Turn on/off AF mode.

TA: Turn on/off TA mode.

PTY: Shows program types, and allows you to search for stations according to different programs.

Phone

This unit allows for hands free calling, using your phone's Bluetooth connection to the unit, you'll be able to dial, answer, access phone book and playback music.

Pair/Connect

Connect your phone to the unit using the below steps.

- 1. Access the Bluetooth connection interface in yourphone.
- Search for Bluetooth devices from either the unit or phone.
- Once connected successfully, the will be a prompt for the password. Input "0000" to confirm the connection.

Dial

Once the phone and unit are connected successfully, you'll be able to make calls from the unit.



Serial/Version: Touch [Serial&Version] icon to enter serial number and verison number interface, to check the needed information.

Seven Colour Light:


Touch icon to enter Seven Colour Light menu.
