
Problem	Cause	Correct action	
	Check fuse	Change fuse same as the old one	
Can not power on	Some factors cause MPU wrong operation	Press RET button on the panel by penpoint, then, power on	
Radio reception is not good	Weak signal	Move the car to another place, then research	
GPS signal is weak		piace, merriescaren	
Can not watch image during driving	It's not allowed to watch image during driving	Park the car in a safe place, put the car stall in "P" position, pull up the hand brake, parking brake wire must be grounded.	
Slow response	Not enough storage space	Uninstall APK or clear FLASH space	
	Open too many APP	Click [□] in the upper left corner to close some apps
