Upon receiving your vehicle (and after reviewing the video) we recommend that you heed the following tips:

1. This 2 stroke dirt bike needs a **mixture of gasoline with engine oil** by ratio of 25:1. A slightly higher oil concentration is recommended for new vehicles at a mix of 20:1 ratio, this allows for better lubrication and break-in. If the bike is not used for more than 2 weeks, it is recommended to burn or drain the residual fuel in the carburetor to prevent the residual agglomeration after volatilization of the fuel from affecting subsequent normal startup and use.
2. Always remember to check and **tighten your bolts** before you ride. You can also use a little Loctite Threadlocker to reinforce the loose screw.
3. Make sure that the pull rope of the **kill switch** is always in a retracted state, otherwise, it may not start normally. If you find that the bike is having trouble starting, check to see if the pull rope is loose.
4. Make sure the **fuel valve** on the carburetor is in the ON position. If it is in the OFF position, there will be no gas flow and the unit will not start.
5. Make sure the **choke** on the carburetor is in the ON position when you try to start this bike. Turn the choke off after the engine gets warmed up enough.
6. Lightly tug on the **pull-start** cord to start. Pull a little bit when you feel resistance and then reset and pull again. Leave the dirt bike to warm up for about 5 minutes and then you can enjoy your ride.
7. Please fully release the **throttle grip** before you hold the brake lever. If you twist the throttle grip and hold the brake lever at the same time, the clutch will be locked and engine will not move again.
