

GETTING STARTED



Power On

- 1. Plug the unit into the power source.
 - 2. Short press power button to turn on/off the unit.

Over-voltage Protection

When DC power supply is over 5V, over-voltage protection will automatically turn the machine off to protect it from burn-out. Please use provided charging cable or qualified 5V/1.0A charger for safety and proper use.

USING YOUR DREAMEGG

Pick a Sound



8 Nature Sounds: Short press this button to choose a nature sound. In sequence they are bird, ocean, rain1, rain2, thunder rain, campfire, cricket, and meditation sound. You will hear an indicator sound when press the button 8 times



6 White Noise Fan Sounds: Short press this button to choose a white noise or fan sound. In sequence they are pink noise, white noise, brown noise and 3 fan sounds.



7 Baby Sounds: Short press this button to choose a baby sound. In sequence they are shushing, vacuum cleaner, fetal tone, gentle surf, brahms lullaby, lullaby, and music box.



Set a Timer

Toggle through the TIMER button until the corre—sponding LED illuminates next to the time of your choice 30,60 or 90 minutes. The unit will automatically shut off after the selected time. If you want to restart, press Power button again.

CO Run Continuously

Toggle through the TIMER button until the ∞ indicator light up, it means you are in continuous mode.

Volume Adjustment

(((

Volume Up: Short press to turn up the volume and you will hear a "ding" sound when volume reaches it's maximum.



Volume Down: Short press to turn down the volume until it's mute.

Memory Function

It will remember the lasting setting of sound, volume and timer, so you don't bother to push buttons all the time!

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Sound machine doesn't turn on	Loose power connecting	Check the cable and power source
	Power button has not been pressed properly	Be sure to Short press power button to turn the unit on
	Over-voltage occurs or fast charging cable is used	Use the provided cable only. See Over-voltage Protection (page 5)
	Charging cord is broken	Immediately discontinue use and contact Customer Service (page 9)
	Power outlet has no power	Switch to other outlets to see if works

	Sound machine is defective or malfunction	Immediately discontinue use and contact Customer Service (page 9)
Unit suddenly turns off once pressing the power button	Power button has not been pressed properly	Be sure to Short press power button to turn the unit on
Sound machine doesn't respond to button controls	Sound machine is defective or malfunction	Immediately discontinue use and contact Customer Service (page 9)
Sound machine cannot run continuously	Choose the Run Continuously Mode.	See Run Continuously (page 6)
No sound when machine powers on	Low volume setting	Press volume up button See Volume Adjustment (page 7)
Cannot find right sound option	Wrong sound mode	Press nature sound/ white noise/ baby sound button to choose a different sound. See Pick a Sound (page 5–6)
