Biological Activity:

GSK5959 is a potent, selective and cell permeable BRPF1 bromodomain inhibitor with IC $_{50}$ ~ 80 nM. It has >100-fold selectivity for BRPF1 over a panel of 35 other bromodomains, including BRPF2/3 and BET family bromodomains. A cellular protein interaction assay measuring the displacement of NanoLuc-tagged BRPF1 bromodomain from Halotagged histone H3.3 was employed to demonstrate GSK5959's cell permeability and disruption of chromatin binding with IC $_{50}$ ~0.98 μ M.

How to Use:

In vitro: GSK5959 was used at 10 μM final concentration in various in vitro assays.
