

If you do not have an App account, you may choose to register or log in by text message authentication. Please operate according to the Smart Life App.


Link FixtureSmart Device to Smart Life App.

Pre-Link Notes:


- This device compatible with 2.4 G Wi-Fi only, please confirm your router is 2.4 G or 2.4G and 5G mixed.
- Enable your smart phone Wi-Fi, Bluetooth and Location permission. (as show in Fig 2)
- Allow your Smart Life App to use location permission otherwise the App will not discover the device (Tap Smart Life App > Me > Setting icon “⚙️” on top right corner > Privacy >Setting > Location > Permissions > Location > While Using) . (as show in Fig 3-Fig 6)






Add FixtureSmart by Auto Scan

Step 1. Set the device in pairing or resetting mode
Switch the power switch 3 times (Turn on –off – on – off –on). Until the lights starts blinking and the device enter waiting net or pairing mode. There are should be a 2-4 seconds interval between each on and off.

- Step 2. Tap Smart Life App > Add device or “+” on upper right corner. (as show in Fig 7)
- Step 3. Discover the device “FixtureSmart” and tap “Add” (as show in Fig 8)
- Step 4. Enter your Wi-Fi code and tap “Next”, make sure your router is 2.4 G not 5G.
- Step 5. Add device and complete the paring work. (as show in Fig 9-11)

Add Manually by AP Mode


If the network in your home is 2.4GHz and 5GHz mixed, or you fail to link the device to the App by Auto Scan Mode stated above, you can use AP mode (compatibility mode).

Pre –Link Notes

- Please allow your mobile phone use Wi-Fi and location permission otherwise your phone will not discover your Wi-Fi. (as show in Fig 13)
- **Disable the Bluetooth permission** of your smart phone otherwise your device will enter auto scan mode with Bluetooth. (as how in Fig 13)
- Allow your Smart Life App to use location permission otherwise the App will not discover the device (Tap Smart Life App > Me > Setting icon “⚙️” on top right corner > Privacy >Setting > Location > Permissions > Location > While Using) . (as show in Fig 14--Fig 17)

Step 1. Set the device in pairing or resetting mode

Switch the power switch 3 times (Turn on –off – on – off –on). Until the lights starts blinking rapidly and the device enter waiting net or pairing mode. **Repeat another 3 times (off-on-off-on-off-on)** , the lights will stars blinking slowly and enter AP paring mode. There are should be a 2-4 seconds interval between each on and off. (as show in Fig 12)

Step 2. Tape Smart Life App > Add Device > Add Manually > Lighting >Lighting Source(Wi-Fi)) (as show in Fig18).

Step 3. Enter your Wi-Fi Code. (as show in Fig 19)

Step 4. Confirm the indicator lights is blinking or breathing **slowly** (as show in Fig 20, 21)

Step 5. Click the Wi-Fi Set up page of your smart phone and find the hotspot that start with “Smart Life” click to connect (as show in Fig 22, 23)

Step 6 .Click to the device’s hotspot and **turn back to** the network configuration page in the App to continue the process. (as show in Fig 24)

Step 7 Click “Done” to complete the add process. (as show in Fig 25,26)

Step 8 . After the device successfully added, you can customize the device name (64 Characters maximum) and assign rooms for the devices.


