Cleaning and Preservation



1 CLEANING

Please use a small soft brush or soft cloth along the blades direction. Brush or wipe regularly from top to bottom. Do not touch the blade directly with your fingers to avoid accidental cuts.



2 WASHING

When cleaning the head it can first shake the head back and forth in the water, to facilitate the slag along with the force of water discharge, then it can be directly washed. Please do not use hot water for a long time to rinse or soak, easy to affect the service life of the product.



3 PRESERVATION

Shake off the water and place it in a ventilated and dry place, preferably hanging, Please do not apply anti-rust oil on the blade to avoid rusting and skin allergy, etc.

1. Take off the older blade head



2. Installation of New Blade Head

How to use it



1 HOT COMPRESS

Apply a hot towel to the hair removal area for a few moments, or open the pores faster by taking a shower to reduce the irritation of the hair follicles.



2 LUBRICATION

Use shaving foam, gel, or cleanser depending on your personal habits to further moisturize and soften the hair.



3 FOLLOW THE SHAVING

Different parts of the beard have their own growth direction, tense the skin, and shave gently and slowly in the direction of hair growth.



4 SHAVING AGAINST THE GRAIN

Shave against the direction of hair growth, so that the blade is closer to the root of the hair, more thoroughly remove the hair stubble.



5 CARE OF BEARD

After shaving, re-wash the skin, and recommend using an after-shave lotion or mild moisturizer to fully relieve skin tension.

ATTENTION: Please keep out of reach of children. According to their own use, every 1-2 months to replace the knife head more health and hygiene.
