I. Safety Instructions

■ Safety Precautions Before Use

- Make sure the rollator is completely unfolded and locked into position.
- Check that the rollator is fully intact each time before using it. Check that the brake is working. Check that the backrest is fixed properly.
- Use only on even and solid surfaces, never on an inclined or uneven ground.

Accident Prevention

- Always use both brakes at the same time! Do not sit on the rollator if the parking brake is not active or if it is at an angle.
- The backrest is not intended to support full body weight. Avoid leaning while sitting as this may result in a fall.
- All four wheels must be in contact with the ground at all times. Only in this way the rollator is safely balanced which prevents accidents.
- Always be careful when crossing thresholds, railway tracks, gully covers with wide slits and the like. A wheel can get caught or trapped in them, stop abruptly and you might fall.
- Do not use the Rollator if any part has been damaged, broken or cracked, or if it is missing.
- Regularly check the screws and fasteners on the Rollator and retighten if necessary.
- Never use in the presence of flammable/combustible and burning substances.

Restrictions on Use

- Use only as a walking aid! DO NOT MOVE ROLLATOR WHILE SEATED. This is a walking aid only and is not to be used as a transportation device or a wheelchair.
- The net bag may be loaded with a maximum of 5kg/11Lbs and do not overload it.
- Do not exceed the maximum user weight: 110kg/242Lbs.

Indication for Use

The VOCIC Rollator was developed for indoor and outdoor use. It serves as a mobility aid with four wheels for people with walking difficulties. The user should have the necessary physical, visual and cognitive abilities to operate the rollator safely.

■ Please Note:

We are only able to issue a guarantee if the product is used in accordance with the specified conditions and for the specified purpose.

Contraindication

The VOCIC Rollator is not suitable for people with very weak arm strength, significant cognitive impairment, or very poor balance. The use and application of the VOCIC Rollator should be assessed and instructed by a doctor or therapist.

Our rollator is delivered pre-assembled.



V. Operation Instructions

1. Folding System

Unfolding



①Unclip the grey closure clip (9) first.



②Grab both handles, pull outwards until the frame is half-open.



③Place both hands on each side of the seat and push downwards until you hear a click.

Folding

Lift the seat by the folding handle(7) and push the handles toward each other.

2. Height Adjustment

The handles should be level with your wrist when standing in an upright position. If in doubt, consult your physical or occupational therapist.



1) Push the button



②Adjust the handle



3 Release



Check that the handle is locked in a secure position.

3. Brake System



①To apply the handbrake pull the brake lever up.



②To engage the parking brake, press the brake lever down until it locks.



4. Backrest Adjustment



1) To adjust the height of the backrest, loosen the hand screws(16), move to the desired height and retighten the screws(16)



②Press the silver clip(17) whilst simultaneously pulling the end of the backrest to adjust.



The fasteners for the backrest should be at the same height on both sides.

5. Sitting

The Rollator gives support when walking. If you want to take a break, you can sit on it. Place the rollator on a solid, level surface. Lock the brakes (parking position). The Rollator must stand and must not slip. Sit straight up.

6. Using the Curb Aid

Carefully press on the curb aid with a foot. Pull slightly by the handles to lift the front wheels off the ground.



Be aware that the stability of the Rollator changes when it is reclined. Be cautious and try to bypass rather than climb high obstacles.

7. Removing/Attaching the Carry Bag

- To remove the bag, twist knobs located on the front end of the seat frame outward. Pull out knobs and slide bag out of receptacle.
- To replace the bag, fold the Rollator slightly and reverse above steps.

8. Transport and Storage

If the rollator is to be stored or shipped, it is advisable to retain the original packaging. Your rollator will have an optimum protection against environmental influences during storage and transport.

9. Maintenance

- Clean regularly by hand with a damp cloth. Do not use aggressive or caustic detergents.
- Avoid long-term exposure to the sun and rain.
- Do not scratch the surface of the rollator with hard tools, sharp knives, etc.
- If corrosive liquid is splashed on the surface of the rollator, please wipe it quickly with a dry towel.



• If the wheels are found to have sharp and harsh sounds, they should be lubricated regularly.
