



# How to start a meeting on Zoom?

After connecting your eMeet CXXX to the computer, start your meeting on Zoom with the following steps.

1. Click the settings icon on the top right.



2. Click the "Video", then select “HD Webcam EMEET CXXX/Jupiter” as the camera device.



3. Click "**Audio**" option, then select "**HD Webcam EMEET CXXX/Jupiter**" as the microphone and speaker device.

**Kindly remind:** Only C980 Pro, C990, Jupiter has the speaker, which can be selected as the output device.
