



Sunflower Pot

Free Crochet Pattern by @Lily's Lyric

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1. Material



① #2 or #3 yarn

② Pot/soil: 3.0mm hook

Other: 2.0mm hook

③ stitch markers

④ tapestry needle

⑤ scissor

⑥ lighter (or hotmelt glue gun)

⑦ hotmelt glue

⑧ wire (0.3-0.5mm diameter; To keep the shape leaves)

⑨ branch (10-13cm; 2mm diameter)

⑩ stuffing



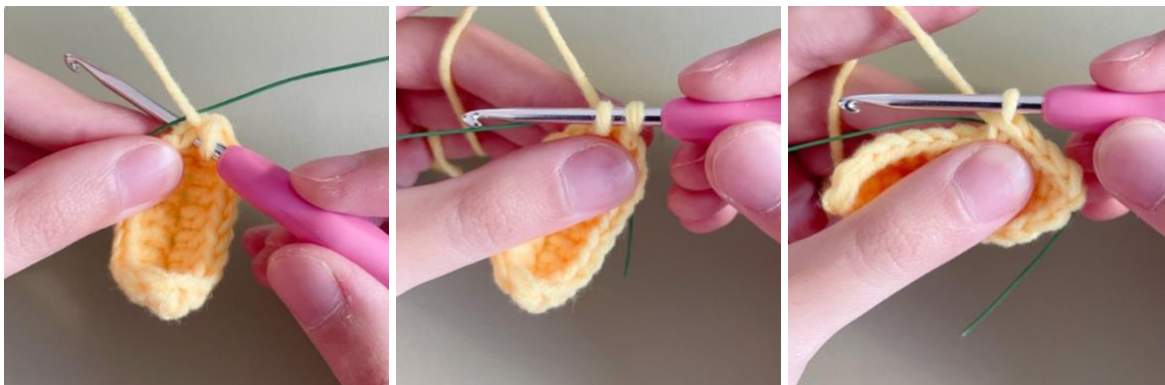
2. Abbreviation

ch	chain
st	stitch
ss	slip stitch
sc	single crochet
hdc	half double crochet
dc	double crochet
tc	triple crochet
dte	double triple crochet
inc	increase
dec	decrease
blo	back loop only
flo	front loop only
(...)	work all stitches on the same stitch
x[...]	repeat instructions in brackets <i>x</i> times
ss(unbold)	slip stitch. It doesn't count as a stitch for the round.
ch(unbold)	turning chain/beginning chain. It doesn't count as a stitch for the round.
turn	Turn the work around and work back into the stitches in the opposite direction.
(put wire on)	Put wire on at the beginning of a round and crochet with wire for this round.
(change color)	Hold the new color of yarn tail to the back of the work. Then, pull the yarn through the last loops on the hook to complete the stitch.

💡 Step-by-step picture tutorial of **(put wire on)**

1. After inserting the hook into the first stitch, put the wire on the hook and under the working yarn.
2. Yarn over and pull through the stitch, and the wire will be caught by yarn.
3. Crochet with wire for this whole round.

* You may temporarily bend the extra wire down, so your hand won't be bothered.





3. Crochet Pattern

- Flower Core (Receptacle)

2.0mm hook | Brown & green yarn

Round 1	6sc in magic loop	6st
Round 2	6inc	12st
Round 3	6[sc, inc]	18st
Round 4	6[2sc, inc]	24st
Round 5	6[3sc, inc]	30st
Round 6	6[2sc, inc, 2sc]	36st
Round 7	36sc	36st

💡 Make one each from brown and green yarn.

- Petal

2.0mm hook | Yellow yarn

Round 1 **9[(2ch, dc), (tc, dtc), 2ch, ss, (dte, tc), (dc, 2ch, ss)]**

💡 Stack the brown and green receptacle together with the right side facing out, work into any parallel two stitches of Round 7, and crochet petals there.

💡 Stuff the flower core when finished 7th petal.

- Small Leaf

2.0mm hook | Green yarn

Round 1	6sc in magic loop	6st
Round 2	<i>(put wire on)</i> 6inc	12st
Round 3	(sc, hdc), 2dc inc, 2hdc inc, (dc, tc), dc, 2hdc inc, 2dc inc, (hdc, sc)	23st



- **Big Leaf**

2.0mm hook | Green yarn

Round 1	6sc in magic loop	6st
Round 2	(put wire on) 6inc	12st
Round 3	6[sc, inc]	18st
Round 4	(sc, hdc), hdc inc, 4dc inc, 2hdc inc, (dc, tc), (tc, dc), 2hdc inc, 4dc inc, hdc inc, (hdc, sc)	36st

- **Pot**

3.0mm hook | White yarn

Round 1	8sc in magic loop, ss	8st
Round 2	ch, 8inc , ss	16st
Round 3	ch, 8[sc, inc] , ss	24st
Round 4	ch, 8[sc, inc, sc] , ss	32st
Round 5	ch, 8[3sc, inc] , ss	40st
Round 6	ch, <i>turn</i> , 40sc blo , ss	40st
Round 7	ch, <i>turn</i> , ss, 2ch, 4[9dc, dc inc] flo, ss	44st

💡 **Picture Tutorial for Round 6~7**

1. This is how your piece should look after you finish Round 6.
2. For Round 7, chain 1, then turn the piece around, and work into the first front loop of **Round 5**. Make a slip stitch, and crochet in the front loops we left on **Round 5**.





Round 8~10	2ch, 44dc , ss	44st
Round 11	2ch, 4[9dc, dc dec] , ss	40st
Round 12	2ch, 40dc , ss	40st
Round 13	ch, 8[3sc, dec] , ss	32st
Round 14	ch, 32hdc inc flo , ss	64st

- Soil

3.0mm hook | Brown yarn

Round 1	8sc in magic loop , ss	8st
Round 2	ch, 8inc , ss	16st
Round 3	ch, 8[sc, inc] , ss	24st
Round 4	ch, 8[sc, inc, sc] , ss	32st
Round 5	ch, 32sc , ss	32st

💡 Leave 30-40cm yarn for sewing.

- Small Sunflower

2.0mm hook | Brown&yellow yarn

Round 1	6sc in magic loop , ss	6st
Round 2	ch, 6inc , ss	12st
Round 3	<i>(change color)</i> 6[(2ch, dc, ch), (dc, 2ch,ss)]
