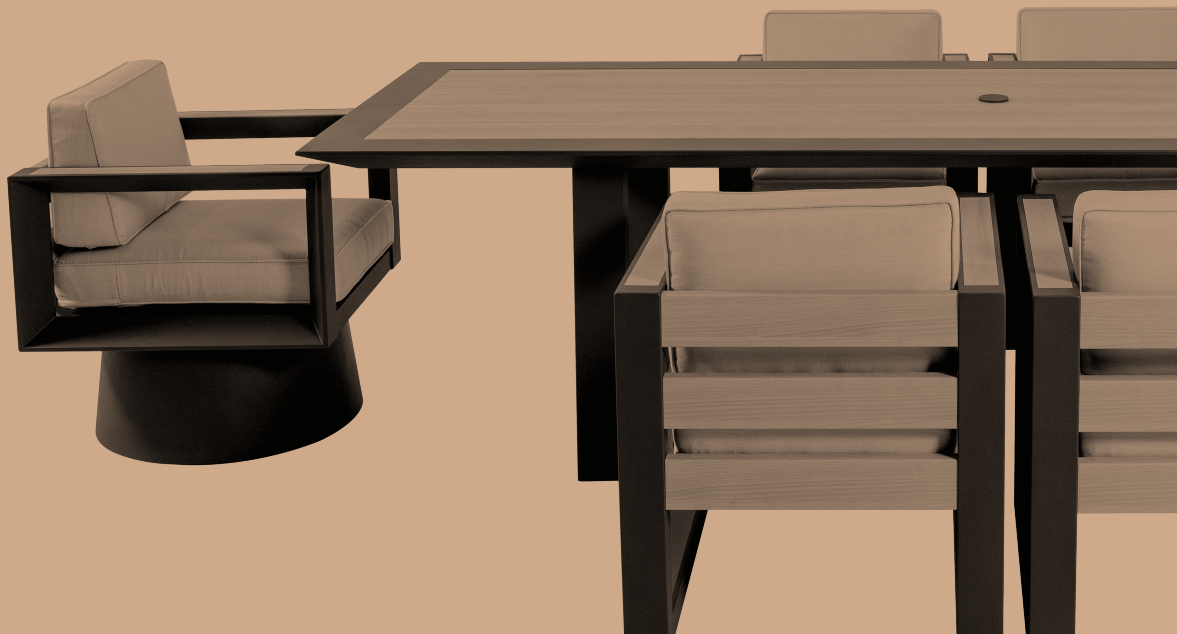

Please only use this product for its intended purpose within a residential environment. Failure to do so will void your warranty.

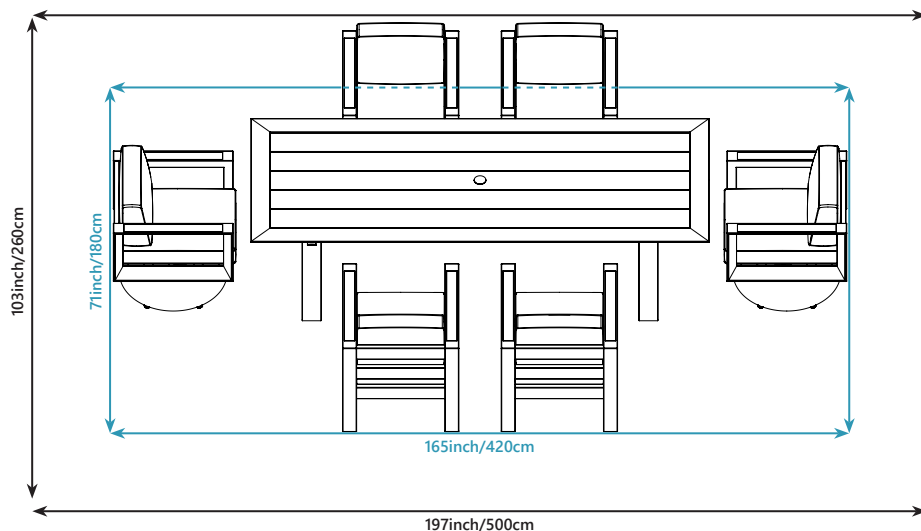

Before you begin assembly, please check that you have all the parts required to assemble your dining set. Please also carefully check that the quantity of parts match with that of the model you have purchased.






If any parts are missing, please refer **Warranty & Complaints Procedure** to contact customer service before beginning the assembly.






Prepare the parts you will need for each step:

In the **Assembly** section of the manual, each step indicates the necessary parts and quantities required to complete the step. We recommend that you prepare the parts you will need for each step. Doing this will save you time and effort during assembly. If possible, place the parts on cardboard or other soft surface to protect from scratching the painted surfaces.

For the safety of all persons assembling and using the dining set, it is important to follow the safety guidelines below.















Adjust and secure the height of the swivel chair and table before using.	Always wear appropriate work shoes, gloves and eye protection when working.	Work well away from power lines, particularly when handling metal parts.	If using power tools or a ladder, always follow the manufacturer's safety instructions.	If damage is visible, stop using it immediately and contact authorized personnel for repair.
				

<p>Always keep the entire base of the chair in contact with the ground. If the chair is wobbly, tilted, or unstable do not continue using the chair until it is fixed or replaced.</p>	<p>Keep children, body parts and clothing away from the swivel parts to prevent them from getting caught in it.</p>	<p>Do not exceed the weight limit when using the dining set. (chair: 352lbs/160kg, table: 440lbs/200kg)</p>	<p>Please recycle packaging where possible.</p>	<p>Only use replacement parts that are approved by the manufacturer.</p>

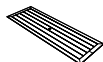

Use a hex wrench **M** to secure the table leg **B** and **C**, table top **A** together with washers **I** and bolts **H**.

Bottle opener:

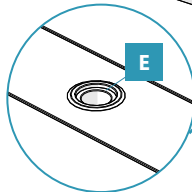
Find the bottle opener at the location shown in the illustration.



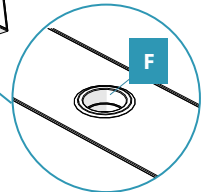
Umbrella hole:

Find the corresponding umbrella hole ring to adapt to outdoor umbrellas with different pole diameters.

Notice: A heavy-duty base is always required to stabilize the umbrella in this using scenario.

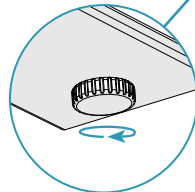

Height adjustment:

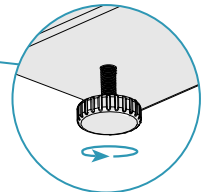
Adjust the height of the furniture by finding the leveling feet screws at the bottom of the dining table leg and the captain chair.

Turn the screw clockwise to lower the chair/table.

Turn the screw counter clockwise to raise the chair/table.



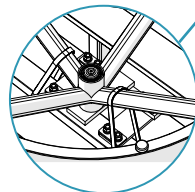

Swivelling:

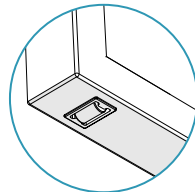
Remove the seat cushion, lay cardboard box or soft cloth on the floor, flip the captain chair over and cut the cable ties.

The wheels at the bottom of the dining chairs help you move the chair more easily when needed.

CARE & MAINTENANCE



FRAME

- Dust and dirt will collect on the frame and will require periodic cleaning.
- Use water or mild soap to clean.
- Be sure to drain any water accumulated inside the frames. Air dry or wipe with a soft clean cloth.



CUSHION

- When the cushion becomes water-saturated, unzip the cushion cover to allow for ventilation and facilitate the drying process. Place the cushions upright with the zipper facing down to drain excess moisture more quickly.
- Store cushions indoors during inclement weather and rainy seasons.



SUNBRELLA CUSHION FABRIC

- Dust and dirt will collect on the sunbrella fabric sunbrella and will require periodic cleaning.
- Store it in a dry area and out of the elements when not in use or cover with commercially available outdoor furniture covers.
- Blot (don't rub) liquid spills with a clean, dry cloth.
- Brush off dirt before it becomes embedded in the fabrics and wipe up spills or clean soon after a spill occurs. The quicker you clean spills, the easier they can be to remove.
- Use water or mild soap to clean.
- Not machine washable.
- Solutions for fabric wrinkling.
 1. Use an iron on the synthetic setting. Avoid using steamers or the steam setting.
 2. Test a small, hidden area before ironing the whole piece due to varying iron temperatures.

Cleaning methods for different stains

- Oil-based spills.
 1. Apply an absorbent such as corn starch, then remove with a straight edge.
 2. Spray on a mild cleaning solution of soap and water.
 3. Rinse the fabric thoroughly to remove all soap residue.
 4. Air dry.
- Mildew.
 1. Prepare a solution of 1 cup of bleach and 1/4 cup mild soap per gallon of water.
 2. Spray on entire area and allow to soak into the fabric for 15 minutes.
 3. Clean entire surface area with a sponge, clean towel or very soft bristle brush.
 4. Rinse thoroughly to remove all soap residue.
 5. Air dry.
