Please only use this product for its intended purpose within a residential environment. Failure to do so will void your warranty.




IMPORTANT SAFETY ADVICE

For the safety of all persons using the chaise lounge, it is important to follow the safety guidelines below.


Adjust and secure the angle of the chaise lounge back before using.	After prolonged use, we recommend you check all the fittings are tightened securely.	Work well away from power lines, particularly when handling metal parts.	Only use replacement parts that are approved by the manufacturer.	If damage is visible, stop using it immediately and contact authorized personnel for repair.

Always keep the entire base of the chaise in contact with the ground. If the chaise is wobbly, tilted, or unstable do not continue using the chaise until it is fixed or replaced.	Keep children, body parts and clothing away from the reclining position adjustment parts to prevent them from getting caught in it.	Do not exceed the weight limit when using the chaise lounge. (chaise: 264lbs/120kg)	Please recycle packaging where possible.	Changes to the design or configuration of equipment may not be made without consulting the manufacturer or authorized representative.


CHAISE LOUNGE CUSHION DISPLAY

Place the cushion on the chaise lounge and secure the fabric strips to the backrest.

Adjustable backrest:

The backrest has 5 reclining positions. Find and adjust to your preferred reclining position before use.





Handy mobility:

Lift the side without wheels first and move it to the desired location.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

FRAME

- Dust and dirt will collect on the frame and will require periodic cleaning.
- Use water or mild soap to clean.
- · Be sure to drain any water accumulated inside the frames. Air dry or wipe with a soft clean cloth.



- When the cushion becomes water-saturated, unzip the cushion cover to allow for ventilation and facilitate the drying process. Place the
 cushions upright with the zipper facing down to drain excess moisture more quickly.
- Store cushions indoors during inclement weather and rainy seasons.



SUNBRELLA CUSHION FABRIC

- Dust and dirt will collect on the sunbrella fabric and will require periodic cleaning.
- · Store it in a dry area and out of the elements when not in use or cover with commercially available outdoor furniture covers.
- Blot (don't rub) liquid spills with a clean, dry cloth.
- Brush off dirt before it becomes embedded in the fabrics and wipe up spills or clean soon after a spill occurs. The quicker you clean spills, the easier they can be to remove.
- Use water or mild soap to clean.
- Not machine washable.
- Solutions for fabric wrinkling.
 - 1. Use an iron on the synthetic setting. Avoid using steamers or the steam setting.
 - 2. Test a small, hidden area before ironing the whole piece due to varying iron temperatures.

Cleaning methods for different stains


- · Oil-based spills:
 - 1. Apply an absorbent such as corn starch, then remove with a straight edge.
 - 2. Spray on a mild cleaning solution of soap and water.
 - 3. Rinse the fabric thoroughly to remove all soap residue.
 - 4. Air dry.
- Mildew:
 - 1. Prepare a solution of 1 cup of bleach and 1/4 cup mild soap per gallon of water.
 - 2. Spray on entire area and allow to soak into the fabric for 15 minutes.
 - 3. Clean entire surface area with a sponge, clean towel or very soft bristle brush.
 - 4. Rinse thoroughly to remove all soap residue.
 - 5. Air dry.

PHIFER SLING FABRIC

- Monthly, rinse the textilene fabric with clean water.
- Immediately clean spills by blotting with a clean cloth to absorb as much as possible.
- · Avoid contact with sharp or abrasive objects to prevent damage or cuts to the textilene fabric.
- During off-season or extreme weather conditions, clean and fully dry the textilene fabric, store in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight, and avoiding humid or moisture-rich environments to prevent mold.

Cleaning methods for different stains

- Genearal Rules (Best Practices):
 - 1. Don't wait to tackle stains and spills.
 - 2. Brush off excess dirt before wetting fabric.
 - 3. Dip your cloth, sponge, or scrub brush into your cleaning solution.
 - 4. Give your DIY cleaning solution time to sink in.
 - 5. Scrub gently with a soft bristled brush.
 - 6. Rinse with water thoroughly.
 - 7. Air dry.
- · Mold/Mildew and Stubborn Stains:
 - 1. Brush off mold and mildew spots with a dry scrub brush or broom, removing as much dusty residue as possible.
 - 2. Combine 1/4 cup (60mL) dishwashing liquid and 1 cup (236.6mL) bleach per gallon (3.8L) of water.
 - 3. Spray onto affected areas with a spray bottle, saturating the fabric.
 - 4. If possible, allow to sit in the sun for 15 minutes, and then scrub gently with a soft-bristle brush until the spots disappear.
 - 5. Rinse with water thoroughly.
 - 6. Air dry.
